
La GUYane vers Les écoiles pus au 21 décembre 2021

Context



December 22, 2021 marks a major events for astronomy: the launch of the Webb Space Telescope

- Astronomy and space professionals from around the world will be in French Guiana to attend the launch
- For this occasion, we propose to organize an itinerant event travelling to the Guiana coast to promote science to as large and as diverse a public as possible, inspired by the project "Planet in French Guiana" (2018 - see www.planete-mercure.fr/planete-en-guyane)





Our objectives

- To present science and astronomy to students and the general public through interactive and playful activities led by astronomy professionals
- To train people to use the scientific method and develop critical thinking skills
- To testify of the cultural richness and international aspect of space careers
- To inspire students and promote the place of women in science to fight against their under-representation








The project "French Guiana to the stars"



- When: from 2021/12/05 to 2021/12/21
- Where: we will visit the cities of Cacao, Remire Montjoly, Matoury, Cayenne, Kourou, Iracoubo, Mana, Awala-Yalimapo, Saint-Laurent-du-Maroni and Apatou
- Who: this project is addressed to three types of audience: students, teachers and the general public
- How: The project is composed of 3 parts



1st part: Students



Two kinds of interventions :

- Webb mission specialists from around the world, astronomy and space professionals, will visit the students to share their passion and their profession
- A team of scientists will lead astronomy- and space-themed activities for the students





2nd part: Teachers



- Two astronomers from the Paris Observatory will train teachers of all levels in astrophysics
- Training will consist in astronomy courses, ready-to-use activities, and an introduction to sky observations



3rd part: General public



Several educational astronomy- and space-themed activities as well as observations of the sun, planets will be proposed for free on markets, villages, public squares, and social centers by a team of scientists
